Peter Clyne is Senior Vice President, Corporate Development at Leidos. He was appointed to his current position following the merger with Lockheed Martin's IS&GS business. Prior to the Leidos merger, he spent 33 years at Lockheed Martin and its predecessor companies where he held executive positions in finance, strategy, and M&A. As vice president M&A and director of strategy at Lockheed Martin's IS&GS unit, Clyne led acquisitions, divestitures, strategic investments, and joint venture transactions.

At Lockheed Martin corporate headquarters Clyne held several staff positions, including Vice President M&A where he led several acquisition transactions. As President, Lockheed Martin Finance Corporation (LMFC), he was responsible for the operations of LMFC, which arranges customer financing and various forms of structured finance to enable sales of Lockheed Martin products and services.

Clyne began his career with IBM and transitioned through Loral Corporation's acquisition of IBM Federal Systems, prior to the combination with Lockheed Martin in 1996.
