Darryl A. Scott is Boeing's Vice President of Contracts. In this role, Scott is responsible for contracting policy, processes, operations and compliance across the company. He serves as the company's representative to industry and government regarding acquisition policy issues.

Scott joined Boeing in 2009 after a distinguished 34-year career in the U.S. Air Force, retiring as a major general. In his last position, he served as deputy commander, Task Force to Support Business and Stability Operations in Iraq, Office of the Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (Business Transformation), and deputy director, Defense Business Transformation Agency, for the Pentagon in Washington, D.C. Prior to that assignment, Scott was commander of the Joint Contracting Command-Iraq/Afghanistan in Baghdad, Iraq. He reported directly to the commander of the Multi-National Force in Iraq and was responsible for planning, executing and managing mission-critical contracting efforts supporting U.S. and coalition forces, security operations, humanitarian relief and reconstruction efforts in Iraq, Afghanistan and Pakistan.

A native of Washington, D.C., Scott is a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy. After initial assignments in computer operations, he transitioned to a contracting career. Scott subsequently served as a principal contracting officer for space; missile; aircraft; and command, control, communications, computers, intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance systems. A career contracting and acquisition professional, his

additional command experience includes serving as vice commander of Warner Robins Air Logistics Center at Robins Air Force Base, Ga., and director of the Defense Contract Management Agency in Alexandria, Va.

Scott holds a Bachelor of Science in economics from the United States Air Force Academy and a Master of Science in logistics management (contracting and acquisition specialty) from the Air Force Institute of Technology. Scott also is a distinguished graduate of the Industrial College of the Armed Forces.

Scott serves on the Aerospace Industries Association Procurement and Finance Council and on the National Contract Management Association's board of advisors. He is a frequent guest speaker and panel member across the industry and government for his expertise on government contracting and acquisition policy.
