PSC Hosts Aug. 15 Webinar on Government Shutdown and CR

WHAT: Unless full Fiscal Year 2019 appropriations are enacted before Sept. 30, some or all of the government will have to be funded temporarily under a Continuing Resolution (CR) or risk a shutdown of all but essential operations. Both scenarios present unique challenges and specialized rules for federal contractors, and it is essential that companies understand the implications and take proactive steps *now* to be prepared. *Media are invited to join PSC on Aug. 15 at Noon for a webinar to learn what companies should do before, during, and after a CR or government shutdown.*

Topics include:

- How should companies adjust strategy, execution, and communication under a CR?
- What should companies ask their customers, and what should companies tell their employees, and when?
